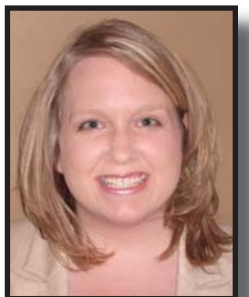

## Historian's Column

### John Mizialko: From Czechoslovakia To California

In my 27 years in this industry, I have had the pleasure of meeting many interesting characters and John Mizialko is no exception. I sat down with John at his home in Chatsworth, CA for a one-on-one interview, but first a little history about his dangerous trek from communist Czechoslovakia to the Golden State. John was born in Czechoslovakia behind the Iron Curtain in 1950. His parents worked in a steel mill but longed to have a better life for John and his sister, Sandra. Later that year when John was only 8 months old, the Mizialko's made a daring escape on a moonless night to West Germany and was taken in by relatives. In 1955 when John was only five years old they immigrated to the United States and lived in upstate New York with an elderly uncle. The Mizialko's were a musical family and made their income playing at weddings, bar mitzvah's and Polka festivals. John's mother was a gifted singer, his dad played the clarinet, his sister sang and played the harmonica and John played the accordion and still does to this day. John, would earn extra money by playing his accordion at high school Polka dances and sometimes on a busy street corner where often a crowd would gather and drop money into his hat. In 1960, the Mizialko's moved to San Diego, CA where they continued to perform as a family band for many years. In 1968, John entered the University of Southern California and graduated with a BS in Chemistry. The interview took place on March 10 of this year with his lovely wife, Jan, at his side.

JL: Thank you for granting me this interview, and as you know I was just about to interview you in 1998 when I was abruptly fired as Historian by John Garruto who was then Chairman of the SCC.

JM: Yes, I remember. That was a bum rap. You should have never been fired. I remember the protestors outside John Garruto's home the week after. They had to use tear gas to disperse the angry mob. Johnny G was quite shaken up by it.

JL: First let's talk about your return to your native homeland several years ago. You and Jan took a trip back to the Czech Republic.

JM: Yes, that is true. It was quite emotional as I was able to visit my home town of Brno.

JL: Brno? Wow, that is an interesting name for a city. I guess the Czech's don't really have a need for too many vowels.

JM: No, not so much.

JL: I find it very intriguing that you learned at a very young age to play the accordion.

JM: Uh, John, you're drooling on the right side of your mouth, are you ok?

JL: I said I was intrigued didn't I? Anyway, you don't find many people these days learning the accordion.

JM: This is true. I remember as a kid watching the Lawrence Welk show and their accordionist, Alexei Smengoli. He played Polka music with such ease. It was a sweet sound. I fell in love with it.

JL: Were you ever accompanied by a monkey while you played.

JM: Only once, but he wanted a bigger cut, so we parted ways.

JL: In 1989 you joined a company called Russ Calvin's Generic Brands.

JM: Yes, that is correct, we had to work on so many different formulas. It was a fun time.

JL: You were the Director of R&D and you hired several people that are presently V.P.'s of R&D or Lab Managers of other companies.

JM: Yes, I hired Moe Witwit, Tim Crawford, and Mark Anton to name a few. Like I said, it was a fun time but we learned a lot. I don't know why fellow employees were always so afraid to come into our lab. They called it, Animal House, but we always got our work done on time and everything was always stable.

JL: From there you moved on to become Director of R&D at Melalueca.

JM: Yes, but I really missed California so I moved back after several years and became Director of R&D at Allou Personal Care.

JL: That is where you developed the J.C. Penney line.

JM: Yes, unfortunately after a few years, Allou ran into some financial trouble so I moved on to become V.P. of Operations at Lifetech.

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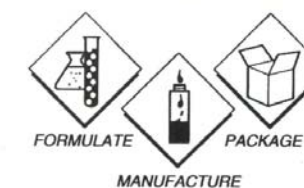

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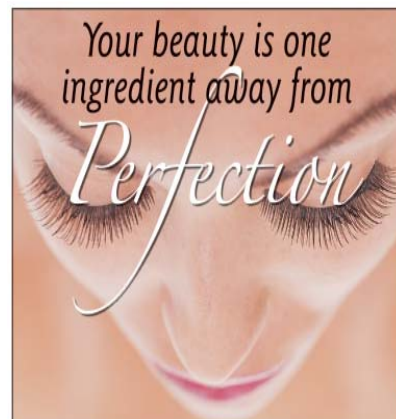


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

**Q:** Do you need to include the preservative in the INCI name of a plant extract if it is not already part of the name of the plant extract mixture or if it is a blend?

**A:** The preservative would not need to be listed in the US if it is not part of the assigned INCI name for the extract. However, if your product is launching in other countries, you should check the rules on traces of substances for that country. For instance, the E.U. Cosmetics Directive does address traces of substances. With the future recast of the Cosmetics Directive there has been different wording proposed in regard to traces. The tentative date that the recast could be accepted would be after May 2009 - but no one is sure if the wording will remain the same or if the recast will go through. Additionally, if you are claiming paraben-free and your extracts have incidental parabens, although not required to list in the US, you are technically not paraben-free.

**Q:** Can you add any parenthetical embellishments which explain the source of the plant or a common name?

**A:** The general rule per the Personal Care Products Council (formerly CTFA) is to not list the common name or any additional information in the ingredient declaration, such as "certified organic", "derived from coconut", etc. You can however describe in your package copy that you are using various organic extracts. The only time the common name is included is if the extract has been known to cause allergic reactions in some portion of the population such as nut allergies, gluten, etc. It is best to consult the 2008 12th Edition International Cosmetic Ingredient Dictionary and Handbook, and list your extract in your ingredient declaration accordingly. As mentioned above, one is free to use the common name in your label copy whilst speaking romantically about your wonderful product. Another consideration would be if your product will be sold in various countries and the common name is listed in the ingredient declaration. In this case the Latin name is universal but the common name could be required to be listed in several languages thus making your label more cumbersome and certainly more expensive to produce.

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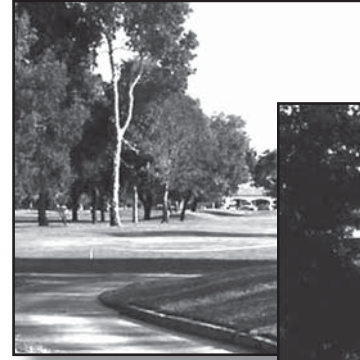
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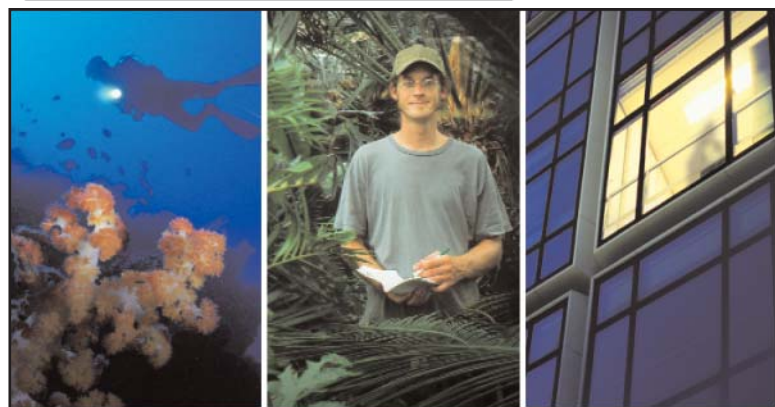
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## In Memory of Henry Frank Maso

On March 2nd, we lost one of most esteemed colleague and industry icon. Henry Frank Maso died peacefully at age 89 at his residence in Skillman, NJ.

Henry received his Bachelor of Science Degree from the College of the City of New York in June 1940 with his major in Chemistry. From 1941 to 1944 he was an Analytical Chemist at the Philadelphia Navy Yard Laboratory. From 1944 to 1957 he was employed in the Pharmaceutical Research Laboratory at Johnson & Johnson. In 1957, Henry joined Amerchol Corporation as Director of Technical Services. In 1970 he became Vice President, then in 1980 Senior Vice President of the company. Henry travelled extensively throughout the world, particularly Western Europe and the Far East, lecturing on the technology needed to manufacture ingredients required in cosmetics and personal care products. Henry retired in 1986.

Henry formed H.F. Maso Associates in 1986 and continued as a cosmetic industry consultant.

He had served with the International Executive Service Corps., a peace corp for retired executives, serving as a volunteer in Thailand and Panama. In 1982 he was one of the first cosmetic chemists to enter Mainland China. He returned to China, at the invitation of the government, in 1986 and 1992 to continue lecturing.

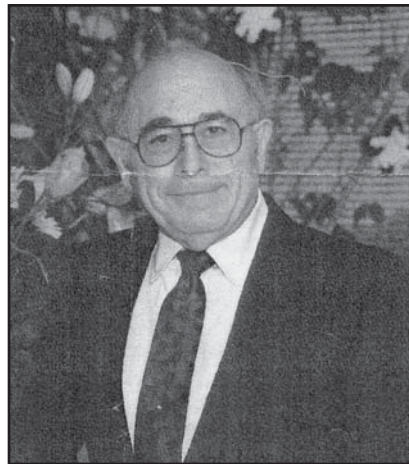
Henry had been an active participant in the Society of Cosmetic Chemists since 1957. He served as Chairman of the NY Chapter in 1953 and as

National President in 1967. In 1971, he received the Medal Award of Federation of Societies of Cosmetic Chemists. In 1983, he was elected President of IFSCC.

Henry had lectured on cosmetic ingredients for the Society of Cosmetic Chemists and had also organized courses in cosmetic technology for the Center for Professional Advancement. He was the recipient of numerous industry awards recognizing his 53 years of contributions.

Henry was predeceased by his first wife, Joy in 1980. Surviving are; his wife of 23 years, Joyce (Mandelbaum) Maso, his children, Jeffrey and his wife Beverly Maso, Roberta Maso and her partner, Pat Bereno, Dr. Martha Maso and her husband Jonathan Tchack and his four Grandchildren, Jacob Maso, Rose Saunders, Jeremy and Madeline Tchack.

Many of you reading this have special memories of Henry and stories to tell for years to come. The best way to honor Henry Maso is to keep telling your stories.

Well, learning can be exciting too. We're going to start a new section in the Cosmogram called *Science...at home*. These are science activities and experiments you can do at home with your kids. Enjoy!

### POLYMERS

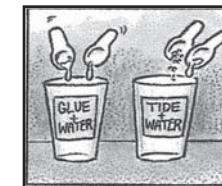
Plastic, rubber, cellulose (which makes up plant roots, stems, and leaves), proteins, DNA and synthetic fibers such as polyesters are all polymers. A polymer is a long chain of repeating molecules. The characteristics of the polymer depend upon the molecules of which it is composed, how they are bonded to each other, and the length of the chain. This unit focuses on the observable characteristics of a few different polymers but does not try to explain these characteristics on the molecular level.

#### Experiment: Goop to Go!

You will need: Elmer's glue, Tide powdered laundry detergent, liquid starch (not aerosol can), paper towels, measuring spoons, water, small plastic cups, straws or spoons (for stirring).

#### Activity 1: Polymer 1

1. Make a chart like the one below to write down your observations. Place 1 teaspoon of Elmer's glue and 1 teaspoon of water into a small cup. Stir to mix.
2. Place 1 teaspoon of Tide powdered laundry detergent into a different small cup. Add 1 tablespoon of water. Stir to mix.

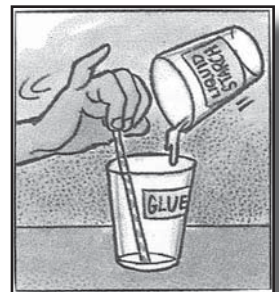


3. While stirring the glue-water solution with a straw, your partner should slowly add the Tide-water solution until a white glob forms in the cup. (This may take between half and all of the detergent solution.)

4. Remove the glob and place it on a paper towel. Cover it with another paper towel and press down gently to soak up some of the excess liquid. Pick up the glob and see what it feels like. Does it stretch, wiggle, or bounce? Can it be molded? Record your observations.

#### Activity 2: Polymer 2

1. Place 1 teaspoon of Elmer's glue into a small cup.
2. While stirring with a straw, your partner should slowly add liquid starch until a white glob forms in the cup. (This will probably take between 2 and 3 tablespoons of liquid starch.)
3. Remove the glob and place it on a paper towel. What do you notice about this polymer compared to the first one you made? Take it off the paper towel and move it between your hands. Record your observations.
