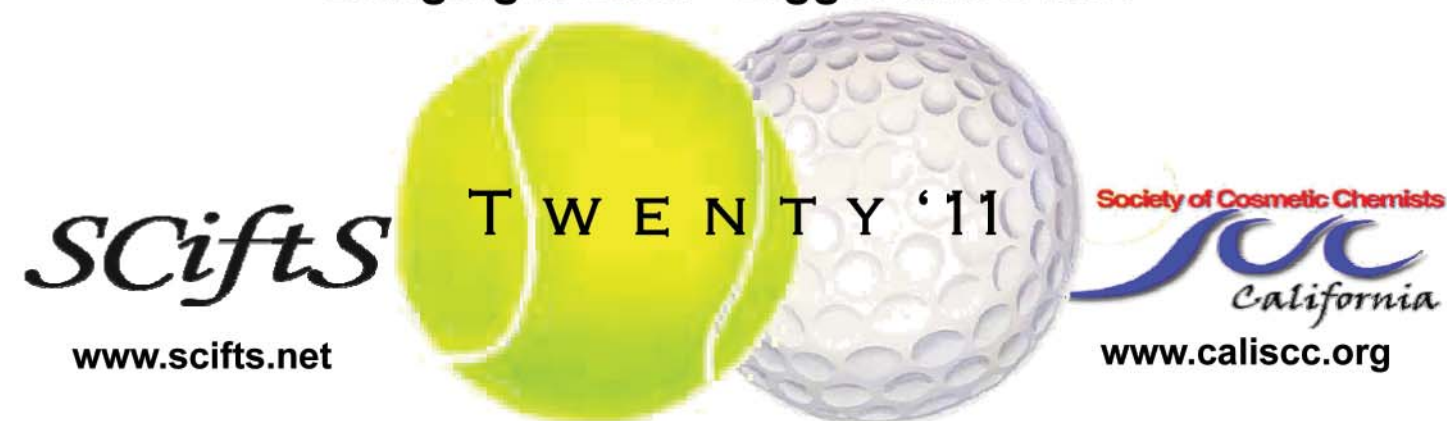

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Who Really Shot JK?

As some of the older members of the SCC may remember, I shared the Historian duties in the mid 90's with Debbie Pierce. We would alternate writing the articles and as you might imagine, Debbie's were a bit more sober and controlled than mine. To accentuate this point I am reprinting my article from May 1997 which is an account of the events of the 1989 dinner dance. So with no further adieu...

When I became Historian I took an oath to tell the truth to the best of my ability. I believe that is what I have done thus far. However in the past eight years, there has been a controversy brewing which will not go away. I was reminded of it again last month while reading Debbie Pierce's column on past dinner dances. It brought back memories of a horrific event that occurred at the 1989 dinner dance. I decided then to look into the facts of that dark and dreary night in February when Judy Katz, wife of Don Katz and mother of current D.D. Chemco owner, Bret Katz was shot in the neck by a champagne cork.

In those days the SCC Dinner Dance was always held in February on Valentine's Day. Don and Judy Katz left their Encino home and made their way to the Airport Marriott. Little did they know several assassins were making their way to the Marriott armed with fine French Champagne. The velocity of a deadly champagne cork can reach speeds in excess of 150 mph. Don and Judy drove their usual route that February evening and even though they had received threats from rival sales competitors, they decided to ride with their convertible top down. After exiting the 405 Freeway they made a left turn onto Century Blvd and then a right onto Elm. They parked and entered the Grand Ballroom of the Marriott. They chatted with friends and sat down for dinner.

Meanwhile a heated argument had started between John Garruto (then with La Costa Products) and Gary Silvers (then with Merle Norman). The argument was broken up and everybody went back to their own tables. What happened next has been confirmed by no less than five eyewitnesses and a home movie taken by Kristen Janvrin (now Kristen Nadolsky), arguably one of the most honest individuals in the SCC. Gary Silvers – with nothing but contempt for John Garruto – quickly ordered a bottle of champagne corked. He shook the bottle 37 times, aimed it at John Garruto, who was sitting 50 feet away near the kitchen, and fired. Everybody in the room was stunned by the exploding roar of the cork. People screamed and everything became frantic as Don Katz arose from his seat and yelled, "Judy's been hit!" She was quickly rushed to the Parkland Airport Marina Hospital. Fortunately Judy was just fine and she returned to the dinner dance.



Days later the SCC Board Members quickly issued a report proclaiming Gary Silvers as the lone corksman. But is that really what happened? I say impossible!! Thanks to eyewitnesses Tracy Gedney, Carol Collins, Bill Doughty and a never before released super eight film by Kristen Janvrin, I have been able to piece together the true events of that evening. I contend that simple physics alone prove without a doubt that it was impossible for Gary Silvers to have hit Judy Katz with a champagne cork.

As stated before, John Garruto was 50 feet directly in front of Gary while Don and Judy were sitting behind and to the left of John. For Gary's cork to have hit Judy, it would had to have entered the right side of John's soup bowl, exit the south side, travel upward at a 45 degree angle, stop in mid air, enter Judy's bread roll, exit and make a sharp right turn to hit her in the neck. Ballistics tests conducted on the champagne cork by the SCC Board Members were inconclusive. So if Gary did not pop the champagne cork that hit Judy, who did? I contend Gary Silvers did not shoot Judy Katz with a champagne cork; he was merely a patsy for someone who knew Gary would shoot a champagne cork some time that night.

As Kristen's film soon proved, Judy was not even shot from behind but rather from the front and to the right. Although somewhat grainy, Kristen's home movie shot from her hand held super eight film camera shows a small shadowy figure and a spewing of liquid coming from the kitchen. By means of computer analysis that was not available at the time, the small shadowy figure was enhanced to identify the perpetrator. Even though to this day that person emphatically denies his involvement, it appears to be Brad Rope. Brad, the president of Bioscreen was upset with John Garruto earlier that evening for cutting in front of him at the bar. As the film shows, John Garruto leaned to his left at the very same time Gary and Brad fired their corks. Gary's shot missed wide to the right but Brad's cork hit Judy, the unintended target, squarely on the neck. No charges were ever brought against Brad by the SCC but it will remain a sad memory of a very dark moment at the SCC Dinner Dance, circa 1989.

Although polysaccharides from macro-algae, commonly referred to as seaweeds, such as Carrageenans and Aquarians, have been well studied and characterized, the attention to the sulfated exo-polysaccharide of microalgae is more recent though extensive studies. More than 70 papers have been published on the structure, chemico-physical properties, exceptional pH and temperature stability and biological effects of these polysaccharides.

In this presentation we will overview the formation of polysaccharide by Porphyridium sp., its structure and biological activities in the alga, as well as possible benefits and effects for our skin. Cultivation of porphyridium polysaccharide and purification of its exo-polysacchrude will be additionally discussed.

Investigation of porphyridium polysacchrude composition reveals that the unique 3-D structure of the polysaccharide generates an organized mesh when smeared onto a surface. This mesh is believed to be provided through its organization and homogenous protection to the surface it is applied on. But physical protection is not merely the story; porphyridium polysaccharide contains negatively charged groups responsible for diverse biological activity against different insults to the algae and skin.

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
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2010 Chapter Awards
